Table 4B: NOTC, Luton & District

The issues listed for 8th June, 1925 ufn, and July 1st, 1925 ufn, were not books, but large double-sided sheets containing all National timetables for Luton, and were printed on dark blue paper. Both timetable sheets refer to the previous operator as: (Late ROAD MOTORS, Ltd.). The books in this table continued to be titled NOTC, Luton & District until May 1930 but had red covers only until February 1930. From March to May they had green covers. June 1930 was the first to be titled 'Eastern National Omnibus Company, Luton & District' but still with an NOTC-style green cover. From July to December 1930, books had a new style cover with a bus picture and were titled 'Eastern National Omnibus Company, Luton Area'.
